WHEREAS, Rule 72 of the Rules of Civil Procedure has been amended, by the Arizona Supreme Court, effective July 1, 2025,¹ and that amendment adopts Rules for the Fast Trial and Alternative Resolution ("FASTAR") Program, and

WHEREAS, this Court has participated in a FASTAR pilot program from November 1, 2017 through June 30, 2025.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Rules of Civil Procedure Rule 72(a)(3), effective July 1, 2025, a decision to require arbitration of certain claims or to establish a FASTAR program must be incorporated into a superior court order that is filed with the Supreme Court Clerk and the Clerk of Pima County, and

WHEREAS, Rule 72(a)(2) of the Rules of Civil Procedure, effective July 1, 2025, requires a majority vote of judges in a county to establish a FASTAR program, and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2025, the Judges of the Superior Court in Pima County unanimously voted to establish a FASTAR program in Pima County,


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, effective July 1, 2025, the Pima County Superior Court

establishes a FASTAR program, and Rules 101 through 126 of the Rules for the FASTAR Program, instead of Rules 72 through 77 of the Rules of Civil Procedure, apply to civil cases within the limits set forth in the FASTAR Program.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, effective July 1, 2025, that the Rules for the FASTAR Program govern proceedings in an action commenced after their effective date. The Pima County Rules for the FASTAR Pilot Program continue to govern proceedings in any action commenced before July 1, 2025, unless the court orders otherwise in a particular action.
